ARTICLE 1- NAME:

The Society shall be known as the “West Kootenay Amateur Radio Club”.

ARTICLE 2-OBJECTIVES:

The objects of the Society are:

(A) To establish, maintain, conduct and promote among the members of the Society and others an interest in Amateur Radio and electronics.

(B) To bring together persons interested in the art and science of Amateur Radio and electronics for the mutual enjoyment of and to further the knowledge of Amateur Radio and electronics both within the Society and the community at large.

(C) To foster co-operation among incorporated and unincorporated societies with similar objectives.

(D) To provide emergency and other communications, which are in the community interest and which are consistent with the Radio Act 1970 R.S.C. Chapter R - 1 and any amendments or regulations thereto.
